Can you figure out which languages are related?

Note: Some languages that are related may not have similar words for these 4 words and others, that are not from the same linguistic family, may have similar looking words, as these are such common words. Indeed, some languages listed are not related to any other language and are known as a '**language isolate**'. Also, words might be pronounced the same or differently, despite their spelling.
