We are delighted to announce the 2023/24 season launch of the ADAPT All Ireland Linguistics Olympiad (AILO). AILO challenges secondary school students to test their minds against the world's most fascinating problems in logic, language and linguistics. Secondary school students in Ireland, both North and South, are eligible to participate. New training materials (overview overleaf) and the brochure have been produced thanks to funding from the Department of Tourism, Culture, Arts, Gaeltacht, Sport and Media under the Cooperation with Northern Ireland scheme. AILO selects the Irish team for the International Linguistics Olympiad which will be held in Brasilia, Brazil in July 2024.

Free Linguistics Module with Post-Primary Languages Ireland



AILO is running a free linguistics Transition Year (TY) module. The module, funded by Post-Primary Languages Ireland (PPLI) in 2022 and designed by ADAPT researchers, AILO and AILO teachers, is designed as teacher-led online resources, hosted on <https://ailo.adaptcentre.ie/tylinguisticsmodule/>. The module introduces areas such as sociolinguistics and syntax and links to a related AILO puzzle.
